Begin your celebration in the lobby, adjoining library and two garden courtyards, for your cocktail reception or ceremony. The grand staircase leads into the ballroom and foyer with lovely windows, 40-foot ceilings, enormous paired decorative fireplaces, Burmese teak floors and stunning crystal chandeliers.
